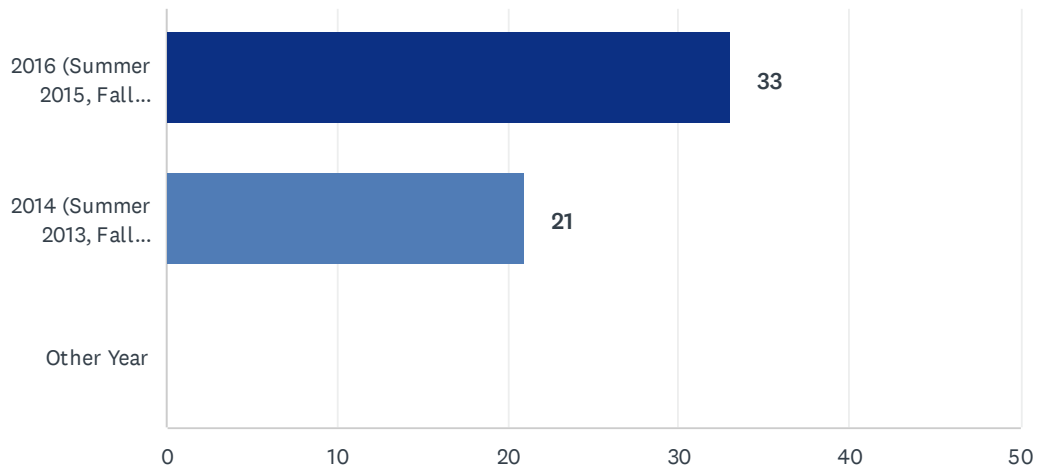

## Q1 What year did you graduate from the RSPH?

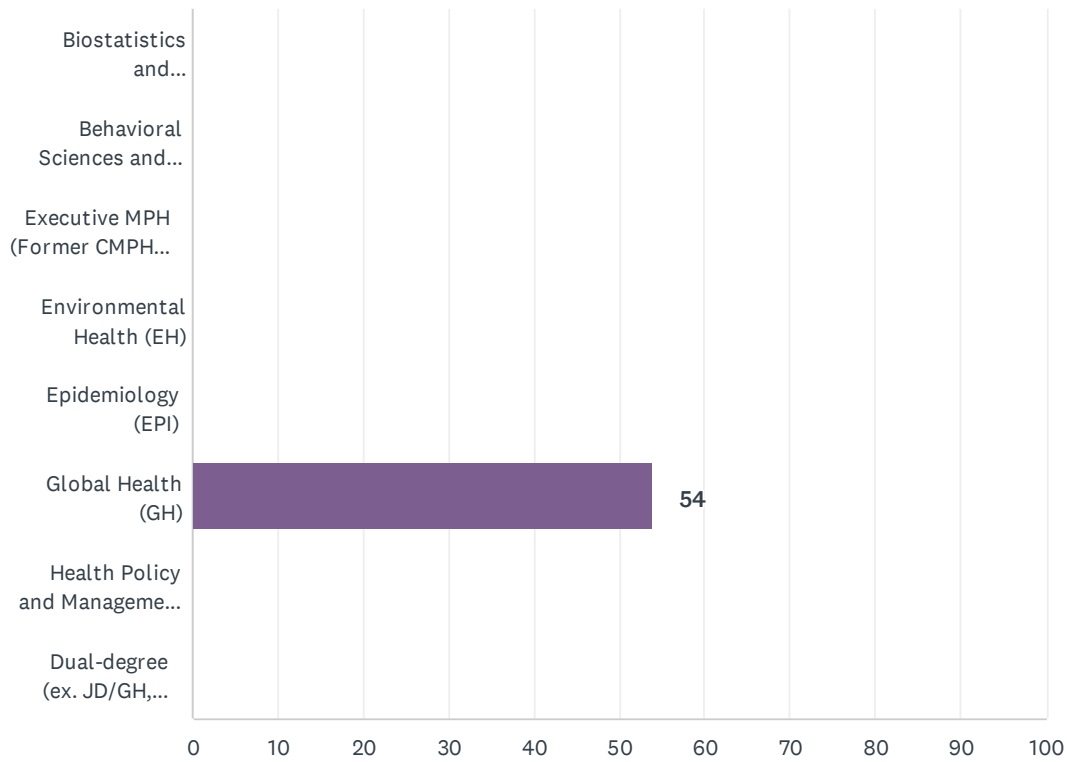

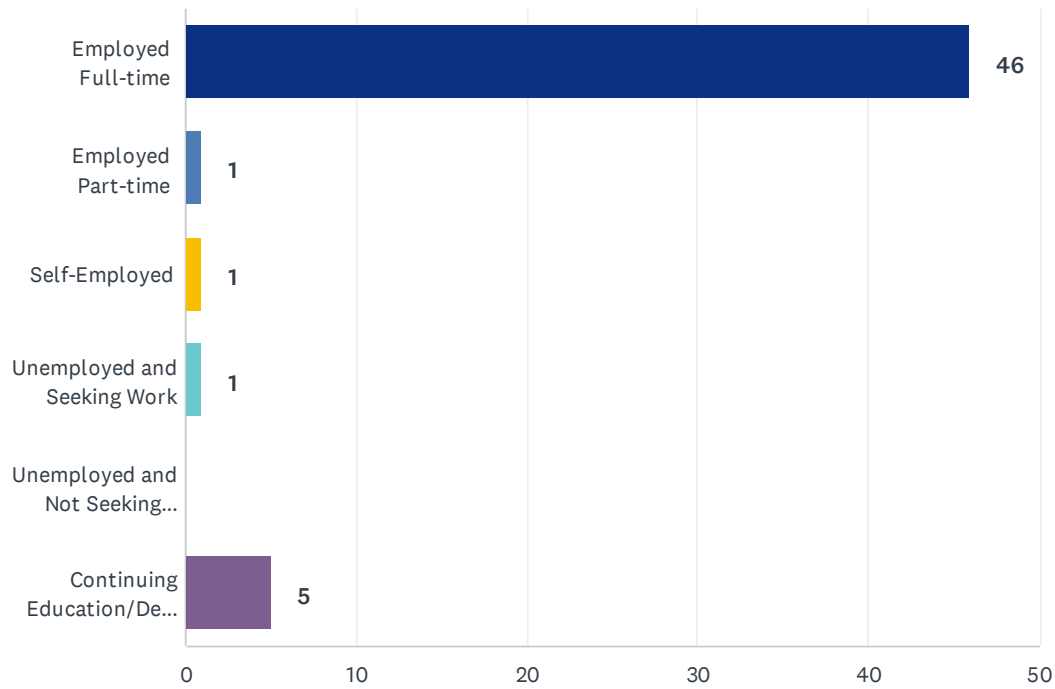

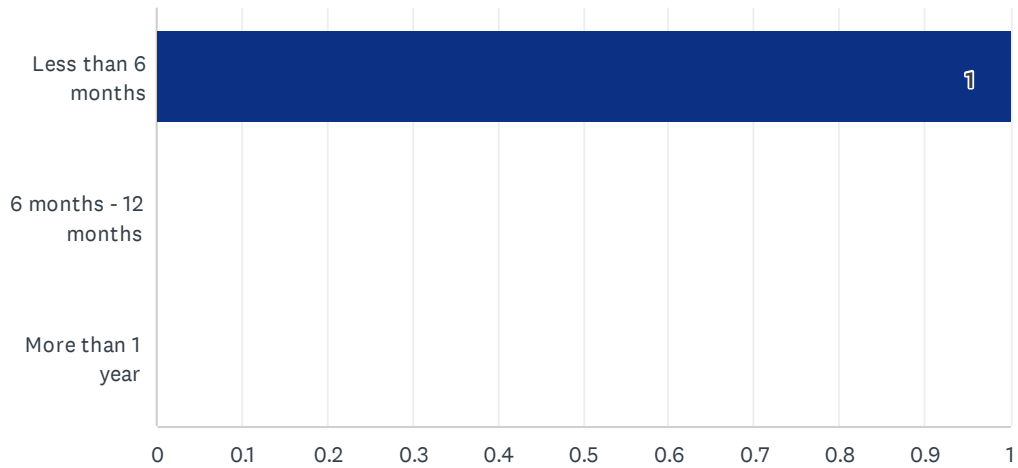

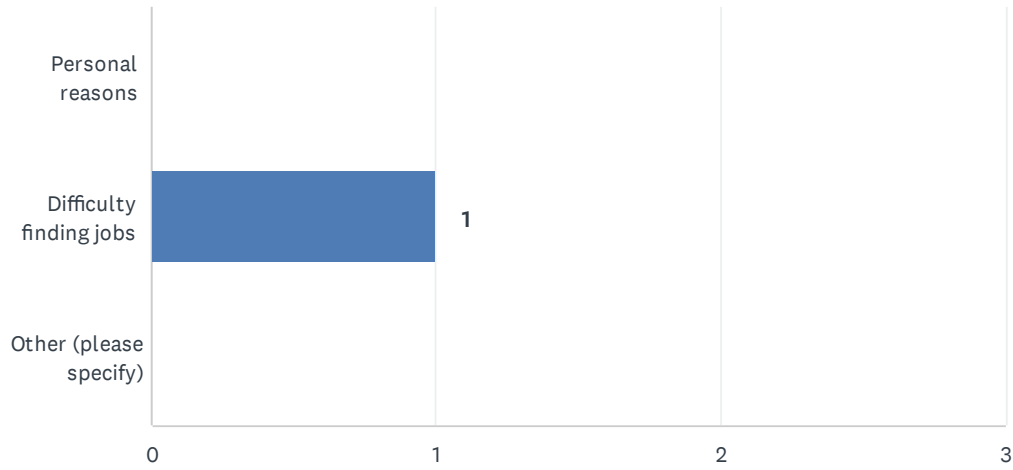

## Q6 What is the primary reason for your unemployment?

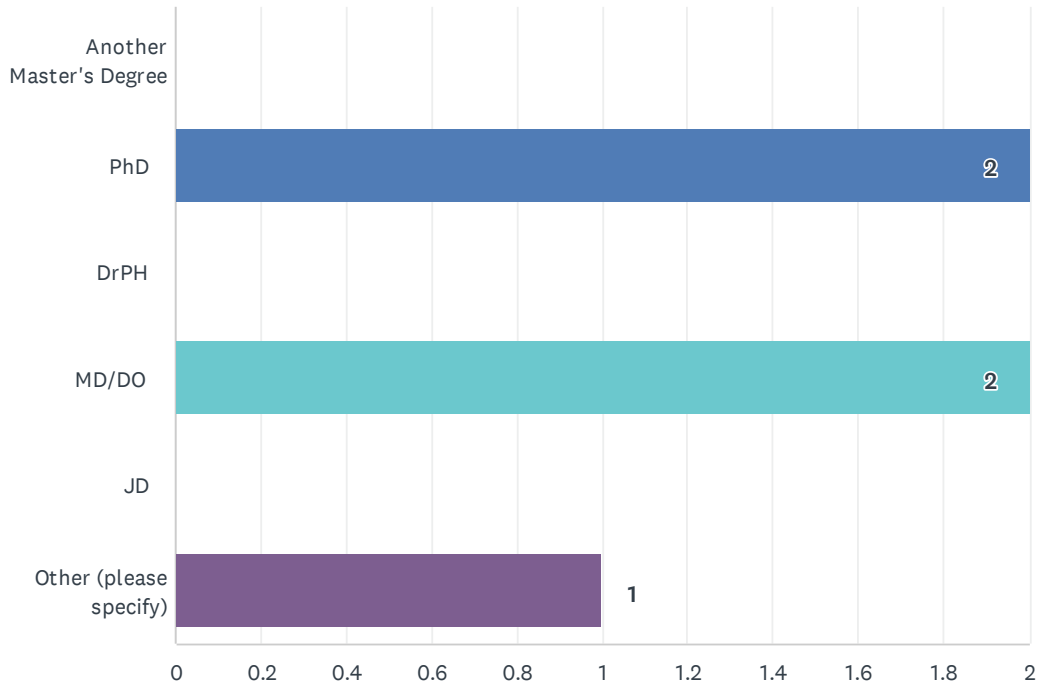

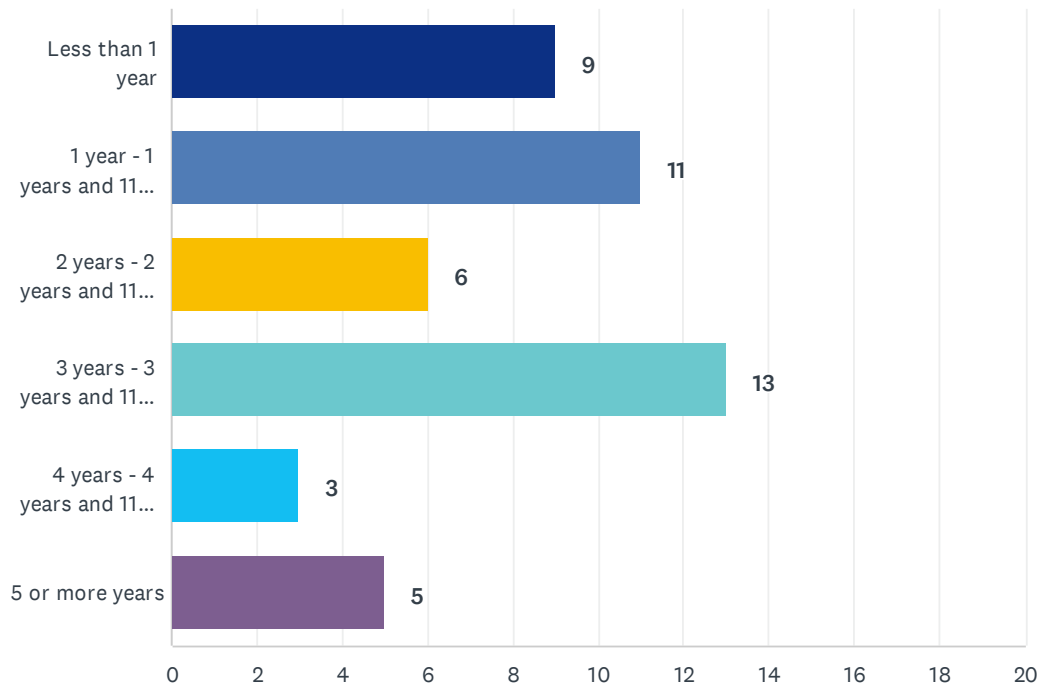

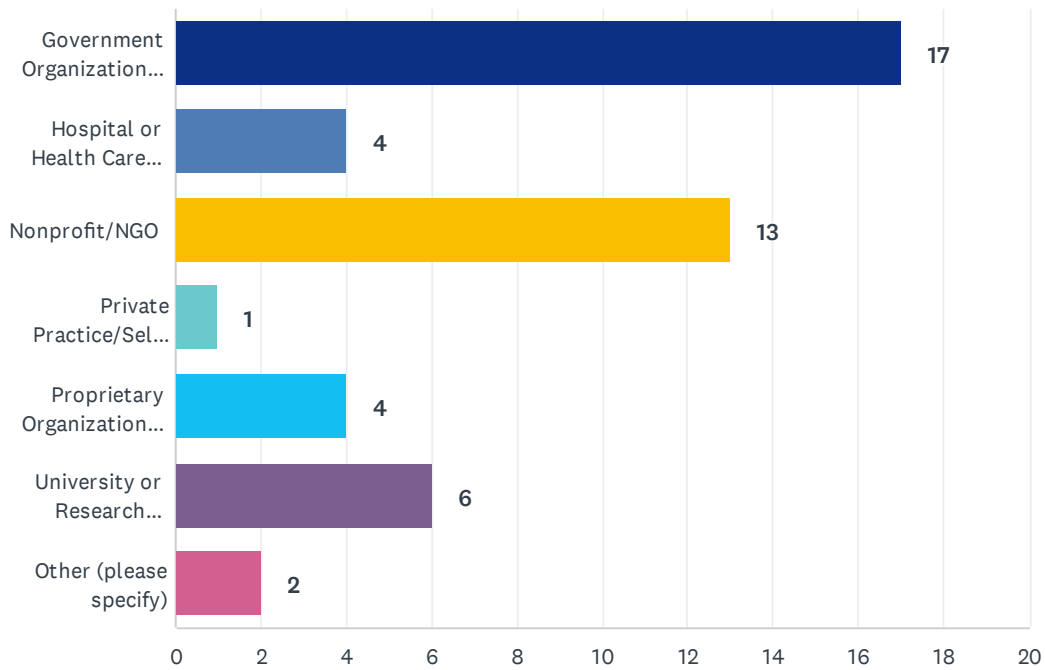

### Q13 Which one of the following best describes your employment sector?

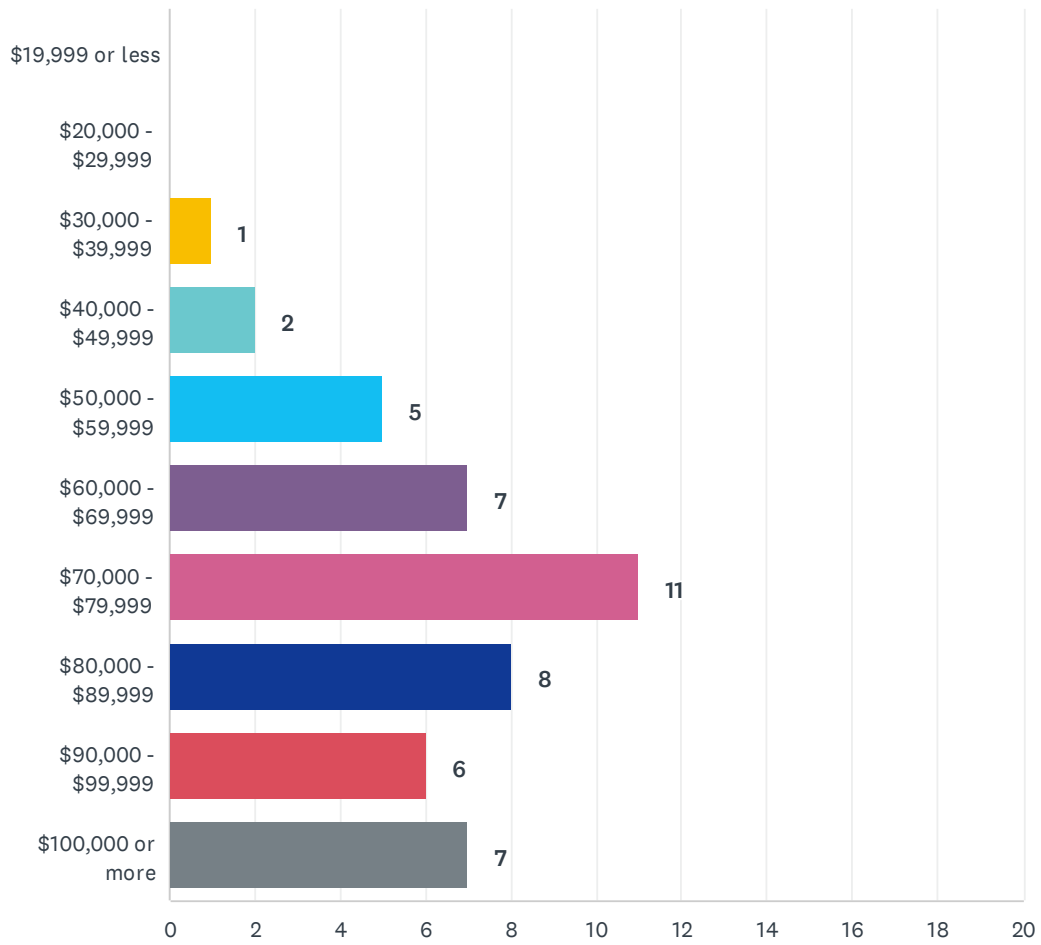

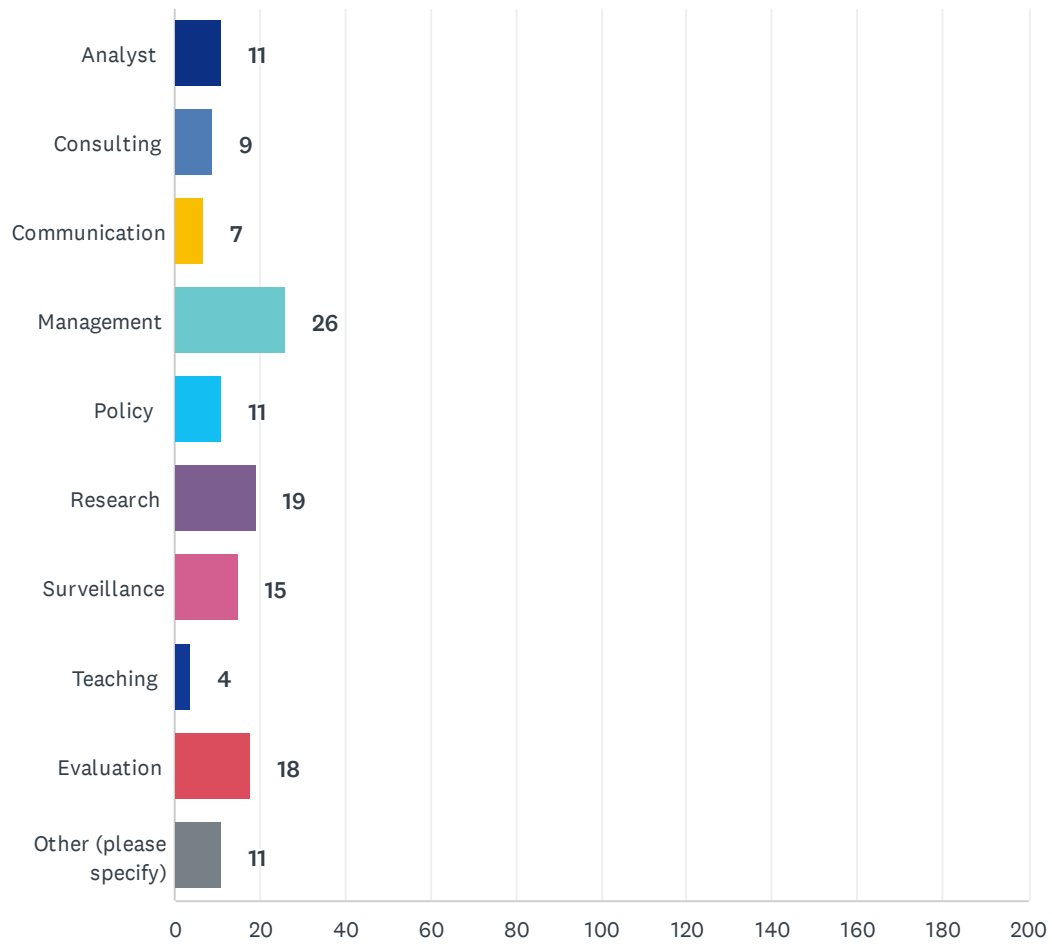

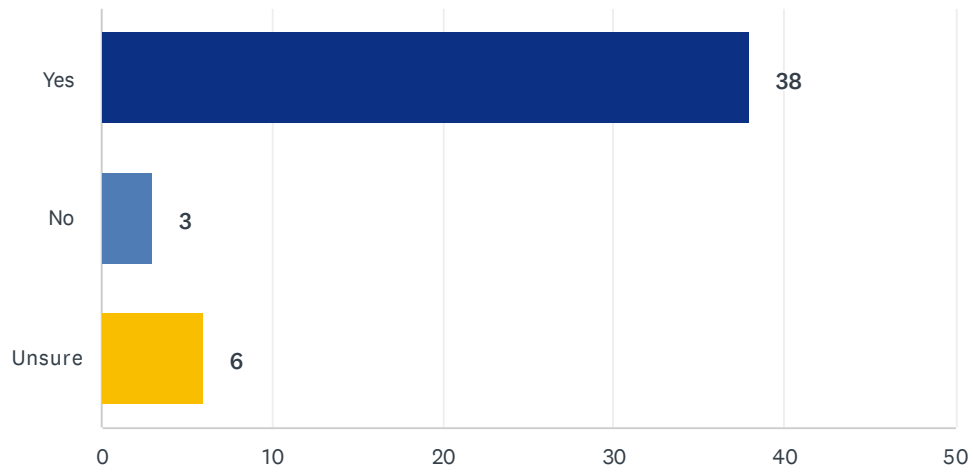

## Q17 Does your current employer hire doctoral trained employees?

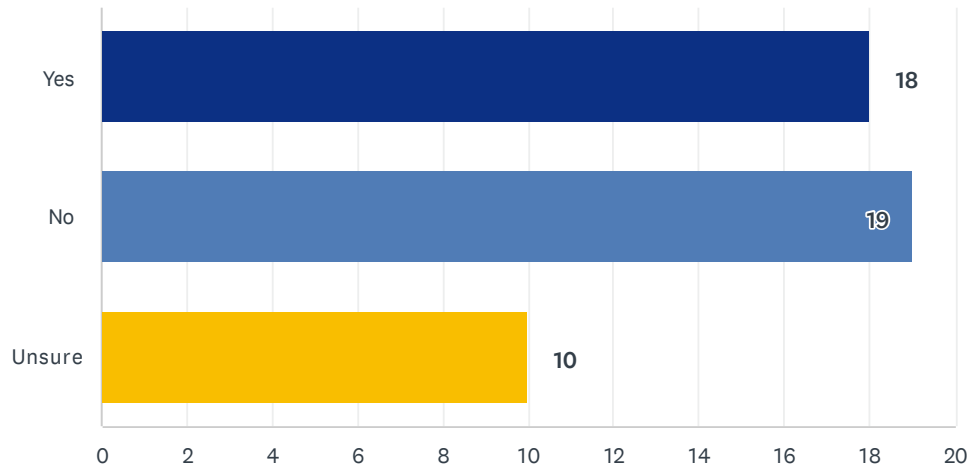

### Q18 Does your current employer hire Rollins students (i.e. part-time, REAL, internships, applied practice experience (previously called practicum) positions)?

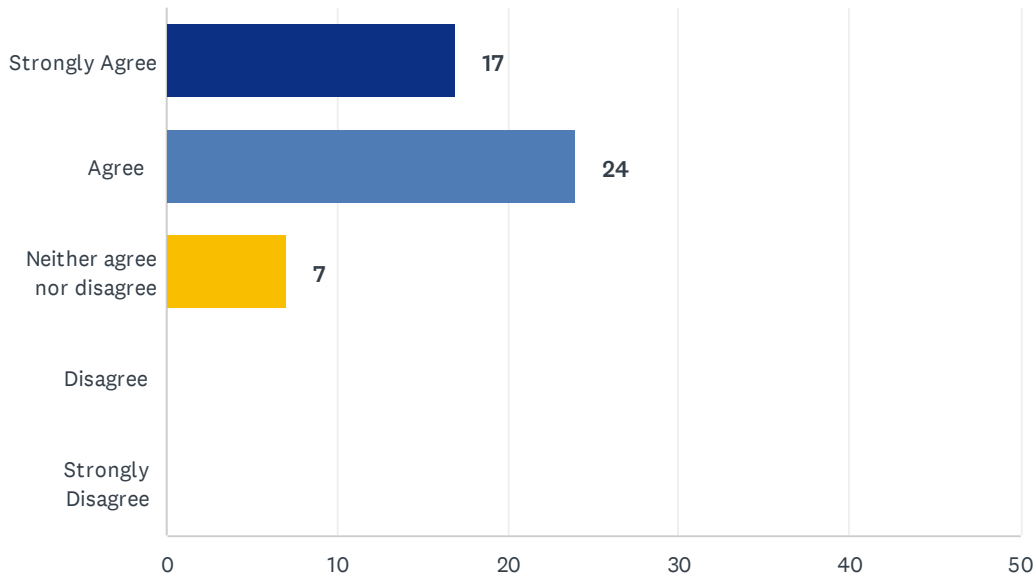

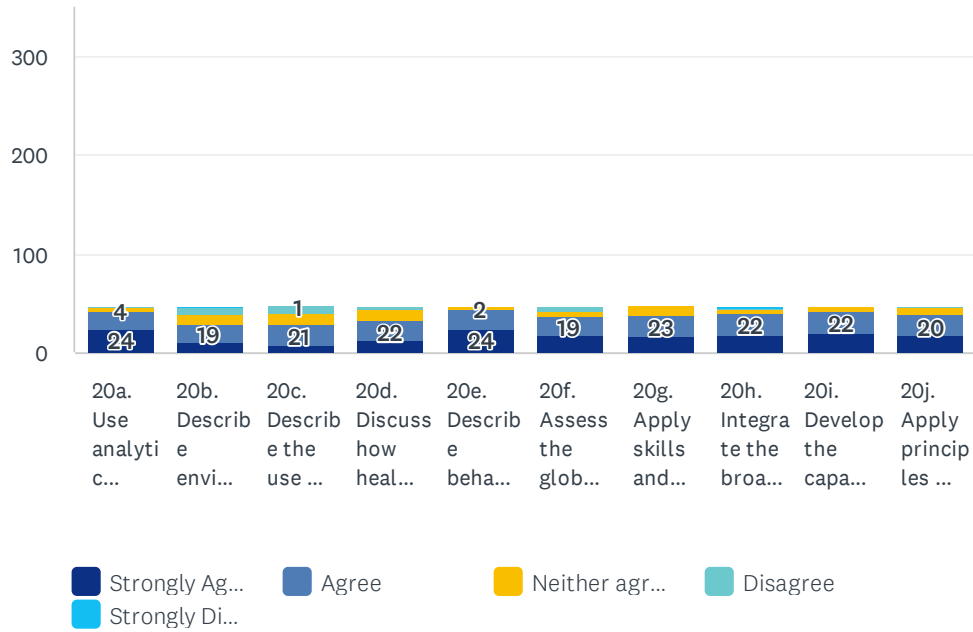

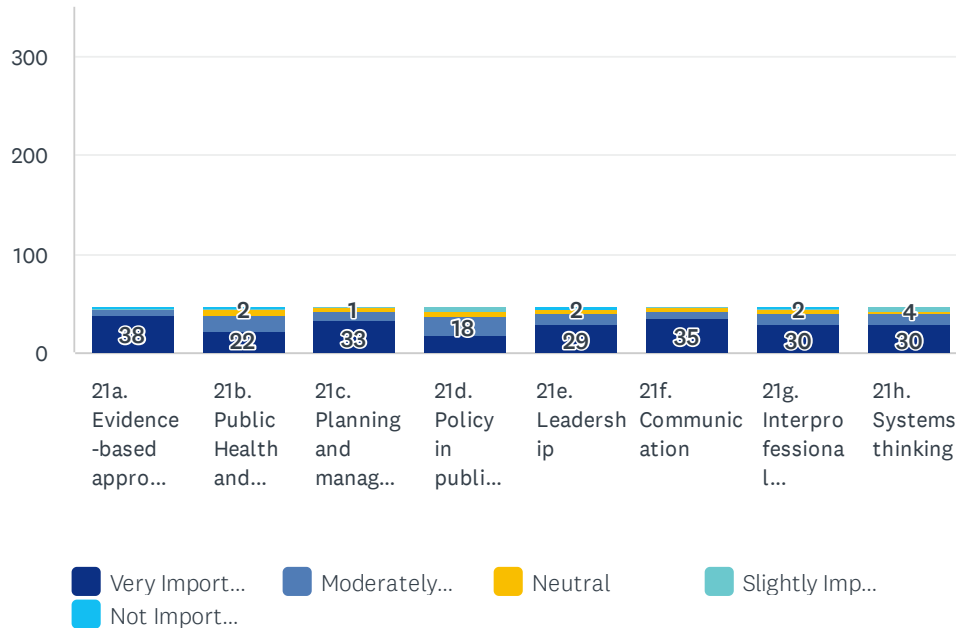

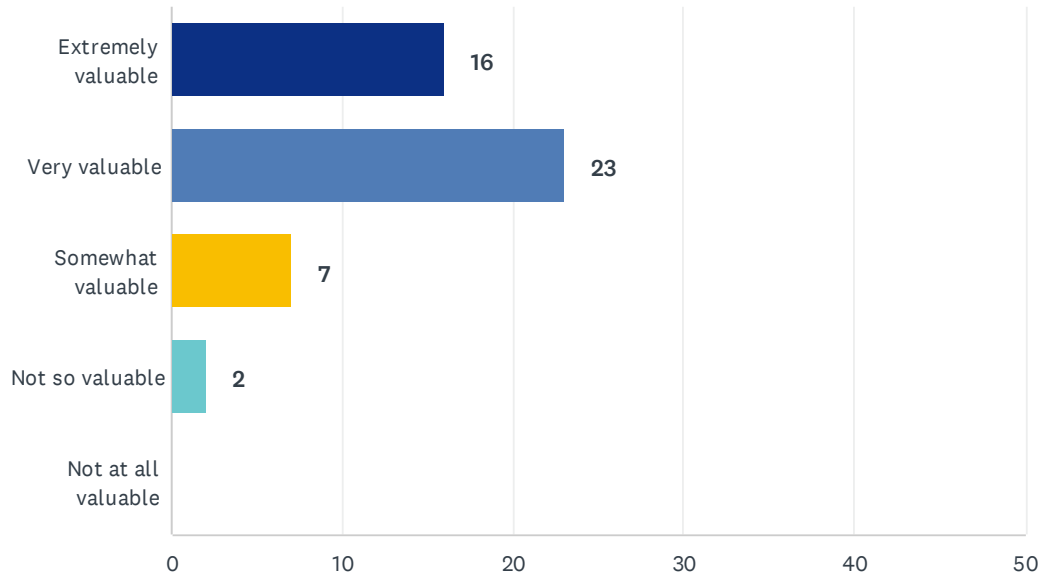

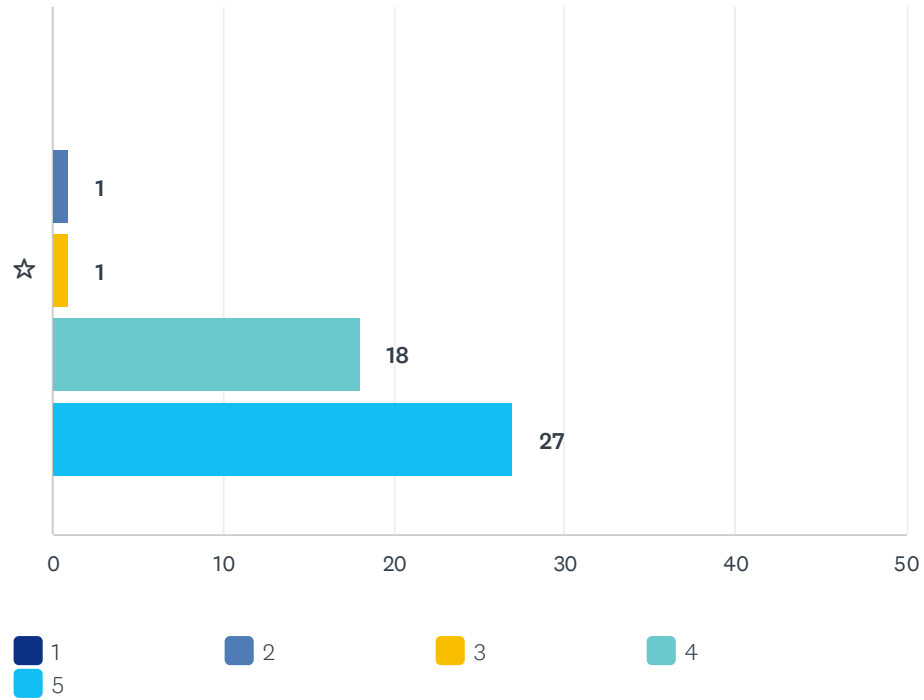

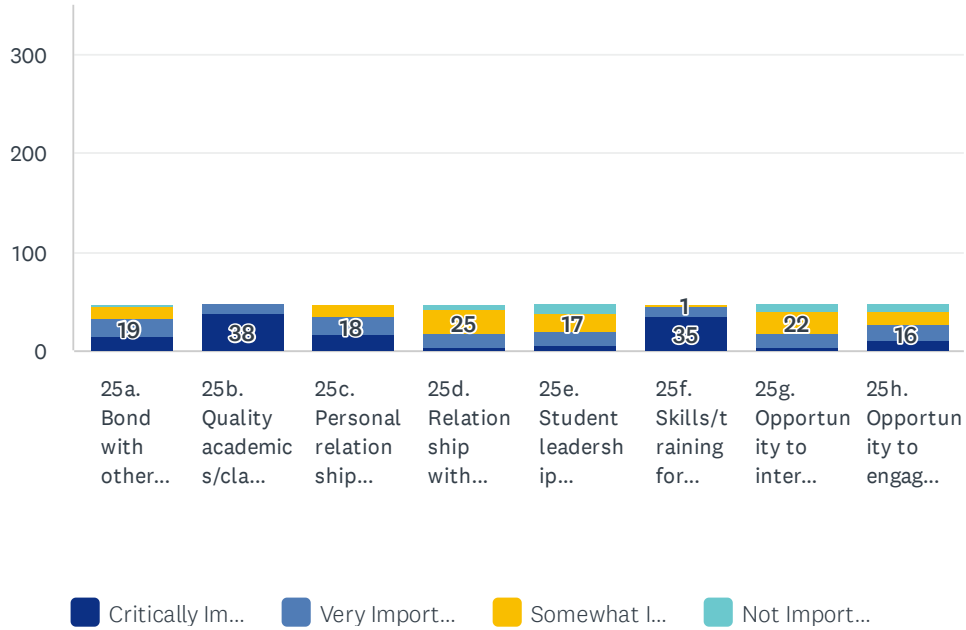

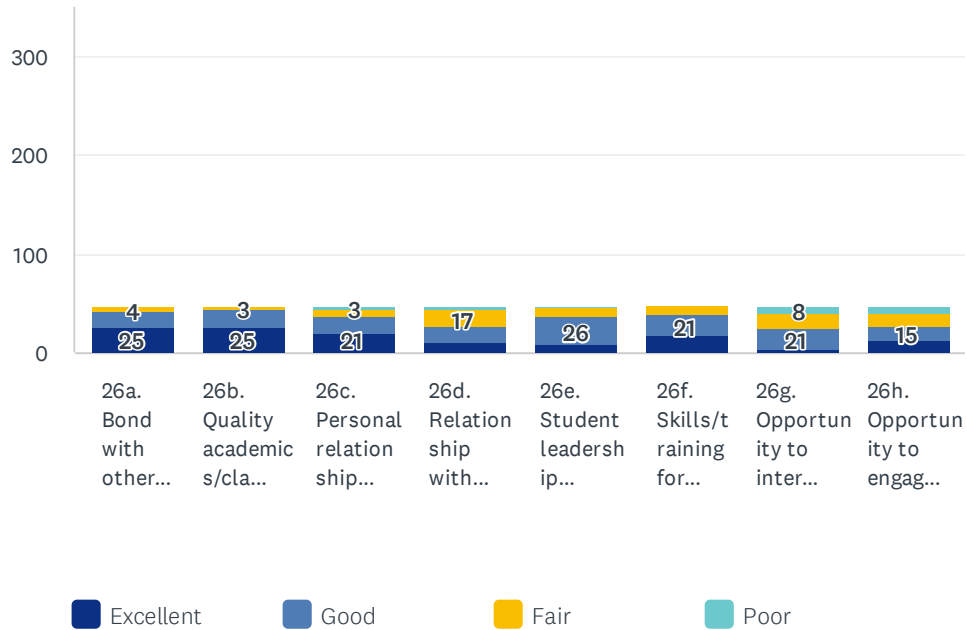

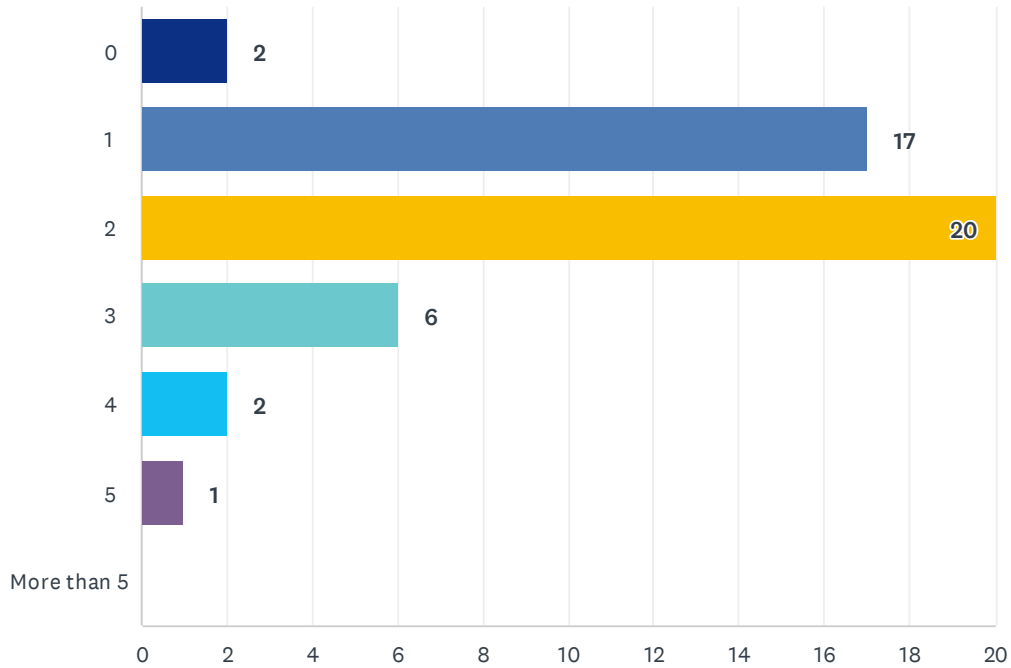
