WRITTING RESOURCES: DID YOU KNOW?

The Emory Writing Center offers class visits.

If you request a class visit, a Writing Center tutor will come to your class to introduce your students to the Writing Center and suggest ways that students can use Writing Center resources to support their success in your class.

Class visits last approximately 5-7 minutes. They ask that requestors give at least two weeks' notice when requesting a class visit. Class visits are often most successful when they occur a few days before a major writing assignment is due.
